## Registration for the 2022- 2023 Faith Formation year

Opens: July 2022 Close: September 1, 2022

All Classes begin the first week of October 2022.

### Sacramental Preparation: Grades 2-3

First Holy Communion is a two year program.

If you are transferring here from another parish, we need a letter from your former Director of Religious Education stating the year(s) of completion.

### Grade Level: Grades 4-5 & Grade 6-8 (Middle School)

These classes are for students who have already received the sacrament of first communion. Activities relevant to special feasts and seasons of the liturgical year are included in addition to class curriculum.

### RCIC: Multi-aged

Rite of Christian Initiation for Children is intended for older children/teens who have not received the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, and/ or First Communion. All students who are ready and prepared will receive the Sacrament at the Easter Vigil in their second academic year of classes.

### Confirmation: Grades 9-11 (High School)

Confirmation is a two year sacramental preparation program. This includes regular participation in Sunday mass as well as meeting 3 times a month for faith formation sessions. Followed by any Diocesan youth event, volunteer service opportunity, and a second year weekend retreat.

### Little ones : Grades Pre-k- Kinder (Opens : Fall 2023)

#### Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Catechetical Program for children ages 4-6. It is a reflective based program of religious formation that helps children develop their relationship with God in a developmentally appropriate way. It is

based on sacred scripture, the liturgy, and the educational philosophy of Maria Montessori.
